### Carburettor Rebuild for a MG TF

Having got the attention of those members with modern TFs this article supplied by Tom is actually for his original TF but could equally be applicable to the SU carburettors fitted to other MG models.



New Carburettors? No, actually they are 63 years old! I sent the TF's carbs away for a total overhaul to a firm called EB Engineering, who advertise in the Enjoying MG, and I have to say, I'm delighted with the results.

The engine bay on the TF is very restricted in so far as access to the carburettors is concerned, but they did go in, albeit with the loss of bits of skin. The most fiddly job was refitting the front air cleaner, and fitting the choke linkage between the carbs. The tiny split pins would be difficult to fit if you could see them, but try it when you can't. After waiting for a bit of dry weather to take it out for a run, and setting things up when fully warmed through, they certainly made the engine run much more smoothly. Not a cheap experience, with each carb costing £175, but for me, well worth it.
