MG SUPERCHARGER KIT



The MGB's B-series engine struggles to break into a three-figure sum of bhp in standard tune, but when equipped with a supercharger, it's transformed into a modern day tourer with the ability to overtake and keep up with fast flowing traffic. A conversion kit is available from specialists such as Moss, budget for up to £4000.

Some of the MGBs in the USA were powered by a low-compression engine, which is ideal for supercharging, whereas it is still feasible to supercharge a standard compression engine, but it must be in good condition.

VINTAGE SUPERCHARGING

Supercharging has long been a popular modification. Driving this 1933 J2 Midget with a balanced SOHC 939cc crossflow engine and a Shorrocks supercharger bolted on the



side results in an impressive top speed of 80mph and lots of fun on country lanes.
