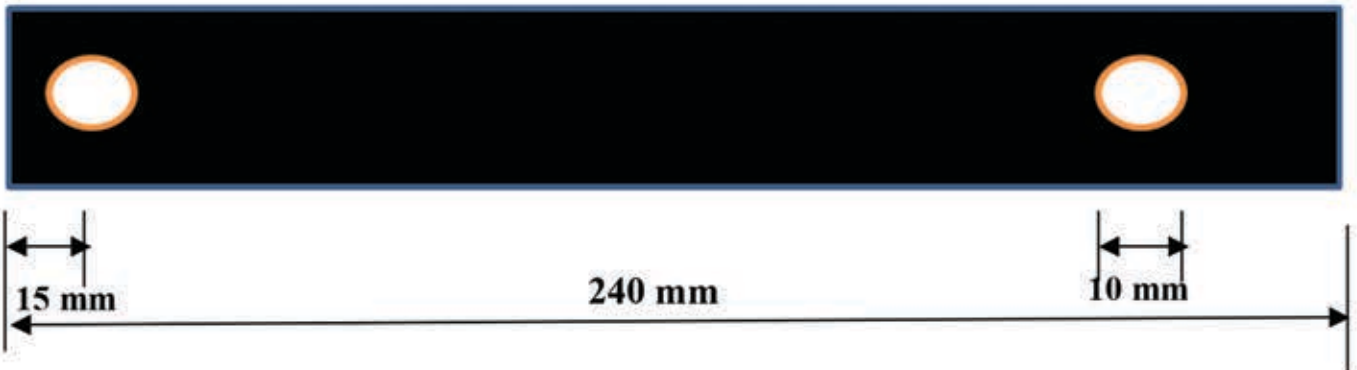


Seat Belt for MGF-TF

(or a little home-made device to stop the seat belt disappearing behind the seat)

Having purchased some seat belt guides for our MGB, I started looking into a similar arrangement for Val's MGF TF. A brief search on line turned up this quick and easy solution.

Using a leather belt of the appropriate colour (in the case of Val's car black) cut 2 lengths of 240 mm each and drill a 10mm hole centrally 15 mm in from each end.



Remove the head rest and fit the strap onto the head rest post forming a loop around the seat belt with a 3mm thick washer in between. This washer is necessary to stop the guide pinching the seat belt and stopping it retracting correctly.



Refit the head rest to the seat. Voila! No more scrabbling in behind the seat to find the seat belt – **Simples!!**
