

MGF30 – Saturday 5th & Sunday 6th July 2025

The 30th anniversary of the launch of the MGF in 1995 will be celebrated in July next year with a 2-day event based at the British Motor Museum at Gaydon, near Warwick. The event organised by the MG Car Club's MGF Register is open to all MGFs/TFs and hundreds of cars are expected to attend (over 600 at MGF25!). Other MGs are welcome to attend.

The **British Motor Museum** is the world's largest collection of historic British cars (400+).

Displays include the Time Road (a century of motoring history), Design & Concepts, Sports Cars, Jaguar, Land Rover and Making British Cars. The museum also has a Motoring Cinema showing archive films, a Café and Gift Shop.
