The Tamar Valley MG Owners Club takes pleasure in inviting you to its "PEOPLE & PLACES RUN" to be held on Sunday 7th September 2025.



This event is a circular social run starting and finishing at Boringdon Golf Club along roads and lanes, offering some stunning views of the landscape and coast of Devon before finishing with an optional cream tea. The route instructions will have brief notes on places associated with famous local people, places and points of interest.

Meet from 8.45 am at Boringdon Park, 55 Plymbridge Rd, Plymouth PL7 4QG. Bacon rolls will be available at the start and Cream Teas at the finish end but must be pre ordered and paid for at the same time as the entry fee. The entry fee of £30 per car includes route instructions, a pen and a rally plate presented in a tote bag, and tea or coffee at the start and finish. We will donate any profit to charity. Flag off will be from 09:30 am.

Entrants will have the option to make stops at various points and there are eateries along the route.

This event is open to all MG Cars, Classic Cars and Car Clubs, other vehicles only at the organiser's discretion. 1. Only the vehicle described above may take part unless a substitute is given prior approval by the organisers.
2. We as the authors of the route guidance for this Social Run reserve the right to alter the route and timing if circumstances beyond our control necessitate such action.
3. You confirm that the vehicle which you are using complies with the current Government requirements for use on the public highway, including but not limited to insurance, road fund licence and any applicable MOT.
4. You confirm that all drivers have a valid driving licence on the day of the Social Run.
5. You confirm that you understand that the scenic drive is a Social Run, defined as a non-competitive run for likeminded participants where there is no other purpose than the camaraderie of motoring in company to a predetermined point and which is not within the jurisdiction of Motorsport UK. You retain full responsibility for your vehicle and your driving, in exactly the same way as you do in driving on any other day.
6. Our role as the Tamar Valley MGOC has been to provide a suggested scenic route for this Social Run using public roads. We have no control over those roads, and we can provide no assurance as to safety or road conditions on the day of the drive as these are for you to ascertain. No guidance contained within our suggested route book should be taken as superseding the Highway Code or any other road traffic regulations, permanent or temporary, as the latter have primacy.
